

## **Dear Legislator:**

I join with the 27,000+ members of The Caring Force in asking you to support the efforts of community-based human services workers. The sector's workers are seeking your support of a student loan repayment program and fair pay for comparable work.

Here are some facts on the human services sector and our dedicated workforce:

- Nearly 180,000 jobs are in the state's human services sector, where workers deliver critical services to one-in-ten Massachusetts residents every single day.
- Average wages for many direct care positions are under \$15 an hour; the state recently suggested providers should pay some workers an average of about \$13.50 an hour.
- Nearly 60 percent of Mass. college graduates in 2017 began their careers with student debt, averaging more than \$32,000 per student a figure that ranked seventh nationally.
- While this sector alone is expected to have nearly 25,000 more jobs by 2024, the prime working age population in the state is projected to decrease by 40,000 people.
