

MA REPAY: THE HUMAN SERVICE AND HOME HEALTH WORKERS LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM

Eligibility Information:

Direct Care professionals and their supervisors who work in programs that provide treatment, support, or services to clients or their families in home-based or community-based human service organizations in Massachusetts. Eligible work settings include organizations and programs funded and/or licensed by one of the following state agencies:

| The Department of Mental Health | The Department of Youth Services |
| The Department of Children and Families | The Department of Transitional Assistance |
| The Massachusetts Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing | The Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission |
| The Office for Refugee and Immigrants | The Massachusetts Commission for the Blind |
| The Executive Office of Elder Affairs | The Executive Office of Veterans Services |
| The Department of Public Health | The Executive Office of Housing and Livable Communities |

- + Applicants must be currently employed in an eligible setting or have an offer letter that indicates future eligible employment.
- + Applicants must work a minimum of **20 hours per week**.
- + Applicants must be awarded a **qualifying degree**. *Please see the table below.*
- + Applicants must agree to fulfill a **1-, 2-, or 3-year service commitment** in accordance with their degree level. *Please review the Common Questions document linked below for service commitment and contract requirements.*
- + Applicants, if licensed or certified by a board in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, must possess a valid license/certification in good standing during the entire period of obligated service.
- + Applicants may not participate in any other Massachusetts League of Community Health Centers program in which there is an active service commitment, concurrently with this loan repayment program. Participation in the federal Public Service Loan Forgiveness program (PSLF) does not disqualify you from MA Repay.
- + Applicant has current qualifying student loan debt that accrued prior to the application date.

Award Information:

Repayment amounts and service commitments are dependent on an applicant's education level at the time of application.

Master's	\$30,000	\$15,000	3 years
Bachelor's	\$20,000	\$10,000	2 years
Associate's	\$6,000	\$3,000	1 year

*Note that providers with a doctorate degree, those with a high school diploma only, and those with no degree are not eligible.
