#### Who is Vinfen and What Do They Do?

Founded in 1977, Vinfen has grown to become a leader in providing community-based support for those in need. With over 370 programs across 500 locations in Massachusetts and Connecticut, Vinfen is focused on helping individuals transition from hospital settings to community living. Over the years, their mission has expanded to include support for individuals with developmental disabilities, brain injuries, and behavioral health challenges. Vinfen's mission emphasizes investing in community self-centered based, support through evidence-based practices. Their focus is on empowering individuals to achieve their goals and lead more independent, productive and valued lives as active members of their communities. Vinfen does this by using the latest science-based interventions to support the people they serve.

They provide a variety of services, including:

-Adult Community Clinical Services (ACCS) and Program for Assertive Community Treatment (PACT).

-Support in building daily living skills.

-Housing services for individuals facing mental health or developmental challenges, as well as chronic homelessness.

-Vocational resources and job skill development to help individuals find and maintain employment.

By prioritizing self-directed, person-centered care, Vinfen is ensuring that their clients receive the support they need to thrive.



### When Did Vinfen Join The Providers' Council and Why?

Vinfen became a member of the Providers' Council over 20 years ago, drawn by the alignment between their mission and the Council's. By joining, Vinfen aimed to transform people's lives and foster a learning environment for individuals, families, and organizations to learn, and be able to achieve their goals. The providers' Council's focus on providing resources, advocacy, and training directly supports Vinfen's work and strengthen its impact across communities. This is partnership strengthens both Vinfen's and the Council's shared goal: empowering service providers to help more people in need.
