I join my fellow members of The Caring Force in asking you to support the efforts of community-based human services workers. The sector's workers are seeking your support of a student loan repayment program and a livable wage for the human services nonprofits sector.

## Please help support our pro-workforce legislative agenda. Here are some facts on the human services sector and our dedicated workforce:

- There are more than 160,000 jobs in the human services sector, where we are dedicated to providing services to hundreds of thousands of state residents.
- Direct Care I workers' salaries are benchmarked to \$20.79 an hour: below the starting salaries offered by many big box retailers
- The one-time ARPA-funded student loan repayment program, launched in 2024, received requests totaling more than three times its \$16.5 million allocation.
