This week, for Membership Monday, we're proud to feature Road to Responsibility, an organization committed to helping individuals with developmental, emotional, and behavioral challenges live full, independent, and rewarding lives in their communities. As a valued member of the Providers' Council for several years, Road to Responsibility continues to empower individuals through personcentered services, advocacy, and community-based support.

Who is Road to Responsibility and What Do They Do?

Founded in 1988, Road to Responsibility is committed to helping individuals with developmental, emotional, and behavioral challenges live full and rewarding lives in their communities. With a strong focus on community inclusion, independence, and personal growth, the organization offers a range of services including day services, residential programs, and social services.

- Day services provide participants with positive transitional experiences such as volunteering, resume development, mock interviews, and workplace readiness training – all designed to support employment goals and greater independence. Through this programming, individuals also receive support around emotional regulation, relationship building, and healthy lifestyles.
- Open Roads Day Habilitation program is designed for individuals 22 and older diagnosed with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD), offering therapeutic day services to help participants gain and maintain independent living skills. The program includes group activities like Zumba, music therapy, individualized behavioral and medical supports, and tailored services for individuals on the autism spectrum.
- Employment services help individuals identify and pursue meaningful career paths through community-based vocational training, job placement, and support in developing strong relationships with employers.



When Did Road to Responsibility Join The Providers' Council and Why?

Road to Responsibility has been a proud member of the Providers' Council for several years, joining a statewide network of organizations committed to advancing human services and improving the lives of vulnerable populations across the Commonwealth. Their mission — to support individuals with developmental, emotional, and behavioral challenges in living full and rewarding lives — closely aligns with the Providers' Council's commitment to promoting dignity, independence, and opportunity for all. Through their membership, Road to Responsibility strengthens their advocacy efforts, builds connections across the sector, and accesses professional development resources that support their staff and advance their mission.

Over the years, their dedication has been recognized through multiple honors from the Council, including the 2018 Supervisor of the Year Award presented to Zdenka Jindrova and the 2022 CEO Award presented to Chris White. Most recently, they sponsored the South of Boston Rally for the Council's Caring Force initiative, held on April 11th, further demonstrating their commitment to supporting and uplifting the human services workforce.
