

FY'26 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

13th Annual Caring Force State House Rally

Increase funding for the Chapter 257 Rate Reserve (Line-Item 1599-6903) from \$207 million to \$307 million. This rate reserve provides critical funding to support mandated rate adjustments for essential human services staff. These adjustments help ensure wages remain competitive enough to attract and retain qualified professionals.

Pass An act relative to a livable wage for human services workers (S.130 | H.223). This bill would eliminate the pay disparity that exists between the salaries of human services workers employed by community-based human service providers and state employees holding similar job titles who perform similar work.

Pass An act relative to a loan repayment program for human services workers (S.119 | H.283). This legislation would provide student loan repayment to human services workers who provide essential services to hundreds of thousands of people across the Commonwealth.
